The Grover Beach Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission will conduct a preview tour of all the nominated gardens and will select the ones to be included in this year's event. If your garden is selected, you can sit back and relax while a member of the Commission will show off your garden.

The self-guided tour is free to the public. Also as part of the tour, participants may choose to take part in the ever popular **Plant Exchange**. Tour participants are encouraged to bring a plant, or plant cutting, and trade it for a new plant to add to their garden. A Master Gardener will be present at the Plant Exchange to answer all of your gardening questions. When you're done touring the gardens and picking out your plant, drop by the Ramona Garden Park Center at 993 Ramona Avenue and enjoy the first concert of the **Sizzlin' Summer Concert Series and Farmers' Market**, featuring the band: **Critical Mass**. The series will continue every Sunday through September 29th!
